Training will be held in the Parish Family Center. If you have previously attended Safe Environment Training through the Worcester Diocese, you DO NOT have to attend the training again. If you have already completed a CORI form in \*2009\* with \*Our Lady of the Lake\*, you DO NOT have to complete another.
